Northampton County officials released an unofficial list of candidates vying for positions in the May primary. Here's a shake-down of some of the more interesting developments:

Forks Township

Incumbent Supervisors Bonnie Nicholas and Donald Miller are not running for re-election, according to the list. Seeking the two open spots are David Billings, R; former supervisor Henning Holmgaard, R; Michele L. Rogers, R; Kevin L. Wall, R; and Simon Sikora Jr., R.

Williams Township

Incumbent Supervisor Robert Doerr, one of three making up the local board, will not run for re-election. Vying for his position will be former supervisor Thomas Houser, D; Tracy A. Brannon, R; and planner Alan Kirby, R.

Easton Area School Board

Timothy Reilly, currently serving a term in Iraq, has filed for re-election in Region II, which includes Easton's 2nd, 4th, 5th, 9th, 11th and 12th Wards and Riegelsville .

Newcomer Jennifer Holzberger will seek a slot in Region 3, which includes parts of Forks, Lower Mount Bethel and Easton's 3rd, 6th, 7th and the 8th Wards, Eastern District.
